Or *Strapless* by Deborah Davis about the young lady seeking fame but got more than she wanted when painted by John Singer Sargent.

We will take a break for an elegant lunch at the Private Members Dining room.

After lunch, we will complete our day with a private talk from a representative of the Costume Institute. Where they will explain the current transformation the institute has undertaken, combining the major collection from the Brooklyn museum, new technology about conservation and its importance as art.
