We will start our day with a private talk with a Museum educator setting the stage for these exhibits and the behind the scenes work of the Museum at FIT.

Elegance in an Age of Crisis is the first exhibition to feature a balanced view of both women's high fashion and menswear and a global perspective.

The elegant and progressive qualities of 1930s fashions emerged during one of the most tumultuous periods of modern western history. Set between the stock market crash in 1929 and the outbreak of war in Europe in 1939, this decade was a startling paradox. *Like Downton Abbey?* – this is next season!

Tired of the old? - *Trend-ology* examines the vast array of sources from which fashion trends have developed over the past 250 years. Trends have emerged from high fashion runways and urban street style, but they have also derived from art, music, novels, and socio-political movements.

After our talk and visits to these exhibits we will stroll down to Le Singe Vert, a delightful French bistro to enjoy lunch together and discuss our Spring wardrobe!
