We will travel through collections of Chinese, Japanese and Korean artworks. We will view ancient objects as well as decorative ephemera, from the Mets vast collection.

After lunch on our own, but sitting together, in the cafeteria – where there is something for everyone – time to visit the **Costume Institute Exhibit** and continue your journey to Asia. Where Sheryl will prepare us and then walk us through the exhibition on her own plotted map.
