Sheryl will introduce us to the art and culture of China and Japan, providing an over view and insight into the artistic traditions of the other side of the world. Get the complete picture of a culture – exploring the impact of Chinese aesthetics on Western fashion and see how it has fueled the imagination for centuries.

We will walk through galleries holding five thousand years of Chinese art, working our way to the Astor Court, a 17th Century style Ming garden created for the Metropolitan. We will see daily objects as well as decorative ephemera.

We will stop at the ever-changing exhibit of Japanese screens and see the collection of Japanese wood block prints.

After lunch on our own, but sitting together, in the cafeteria – where there is something for everyone – time to visit the **Costume Institute Exhibit** and continue your journey to Asia.
