The Middle Kingdom heralded in a great cultural flowering, touching religious, and political traditions evidenced in the collected ancient artifacts. We will journey through the galleries of this special exhibition and I help you understand the Ancient Egyptian culture and the connection to the objects. Learn how their belief in the afterlife influenced and dominated their life and social structure. See how the daily life of the Egyptians is recorded through art. Learn why funerary items are treasured as art.

After we lunch in the Cafeteria, I will guide you through the permanent Egyptian galleries. Where I will introduce you to a female Pharaoh. I will show you some of the artifacts relating to the famous King Tut and walk through the Temple of Dendur. I will also point out some special correlations to Passover from the Book of the Dead.
