Meet me at the Met: at 11:00 when **Sheryl Intrator Urman**, artist and art lecturer, will be our Docent and take us through Mets European Galleries that hold the most beautiful Impressionist paintings. Gain an overview of the life and times of artists in France in the late 1800s, learn why they wanted to break away from the traditional academic art and how changes in the world helped them create a new form of Art which is now loved the world over. Learn why artists like Claude Monet, August Renoir, Edgar Degas, Paul Cezanne and Camille Pissarro were looked at as radicals of their time.

After Lunch, We will continue on through the Impressionist Galleries linking to the History of the times and scientific, technological changes about paint that changed the world! She will be highlighting the **role of Fashion** in so many of the pictures. These tours, both before and after lunch, prepares us for a visit to the **Costume Institute** exhibit of masterworks by designers who have changed the course of fashion history and advanced *fashion as an art form*. AND prepares us for a future visit to the later stages of Impressionism and the Seurat special exhibit in early March.
