Over lunch on our own but sitting together in the Cafeteria, we will discuss Percy Jackson and the stories of Rick Riordan. You will be able to share your memories about his books and your love of mythology with us.

Then we will see how Hellenization worked its way through the Roman Culture by studying their art. We will also stop at the artifacts left in Pompeii when Mount Vesuvius erupted, encasing a Roman City. We will discuss **Chanukah, the Maccabee uprising and victory. We will also touch on the destruction of the 2nd Temple by the Romans.**
