DELACROIX A RETROSPECTIVE!
and
Introduction to the Art World of France
in the early 19th century
Monday, December 17th

We all know the name Delacroix, he was the most famous French artist of the early 19th century. But most of us don't know his art. The Metropolitan Museum of Art, together with the Louvre Museum from Paris have put together this amazing exhibition which include more than 150 paintings, drawings, prints, and manuscripts—many never before seen in the United States.

Delacroix was a rebel against the establishment of the dictates set by the Paris Art Salon. His art work touched on contemporary and political issues. He is known as a Romantic painter who also specialized in Orientalism.

First, we will visit the *European Art galleries* to become acquainted with the Paris Art Salon and the Neo Classic style of art. Then we will visit the galleries representing the *Art of the Arab Lands* which include furnished rooms filled with the kinds of objects that inspired Delacroix on his visit to Morocco, with a style which became known as Orientalism.

After lunch, we will start our tour of DELACROIX, we will get to know this man respected by the French Art Salon, the French public and also his fellowed artists. We will view paintings of his friends, and get to know his interests in animals, religion and the romantic novels and poems which inspired Delacroix to create his artwork. We will see how his trip to Morocco inspired him through out his life.
