

This Exhibition showing a Jewish Legacy, is about to Close.

The Cloisters.... how many of you haven't been here yet?...or not recently? Or if you joined us for the amazing Heavenly Bodies costume exhibit - join us again for a fascinating tribute to Jewish artistry in this uniquely Christian setting.

Meet at the Cloisters: <u>at 10:45</u> when Sheryl Intrator Urman, artist, curator, teacher and art lecturer, will be our Docent will lead us for a 90 minute tour discovering the highlights of the Cloisters and this direct-from-France exhibit of hidden jewels. She will focus on Jewish Life during the Medieval time. For more than 500 years, a small cache of jewelry and coins lay hidden within the walls of a house in Colmar, France. Secreted there in the 14th century and discovered in 1863, these treasures comprised of fantastically jeweled rings and brooches. The precious possessions of a single family! Note the inscription *mazel tov* on a ring - a link to the Jewish community, who were brutally scapegoated and put to death when the Plague struck the region in 1348 - a tribute to Jewish artistic heritage and its role in art and society in medieval Europe. Our experience in days of yore will also include highlights of the culture and folklore, we will touch upon the role of women, mythology, medicine and more. See the 'old stuff' in a new light. And of course the Unicorn tapestries.

OPTIONAL LUNCH: You may wish to lunch at the lovely **New Leaf restaurant** in the hidden 'treasure' of Fort Tryon Park after my tour. Just a short walk to the Cloisters afterwards. Or have a coffee and snack in the Cloister's Garden, after my tour.
